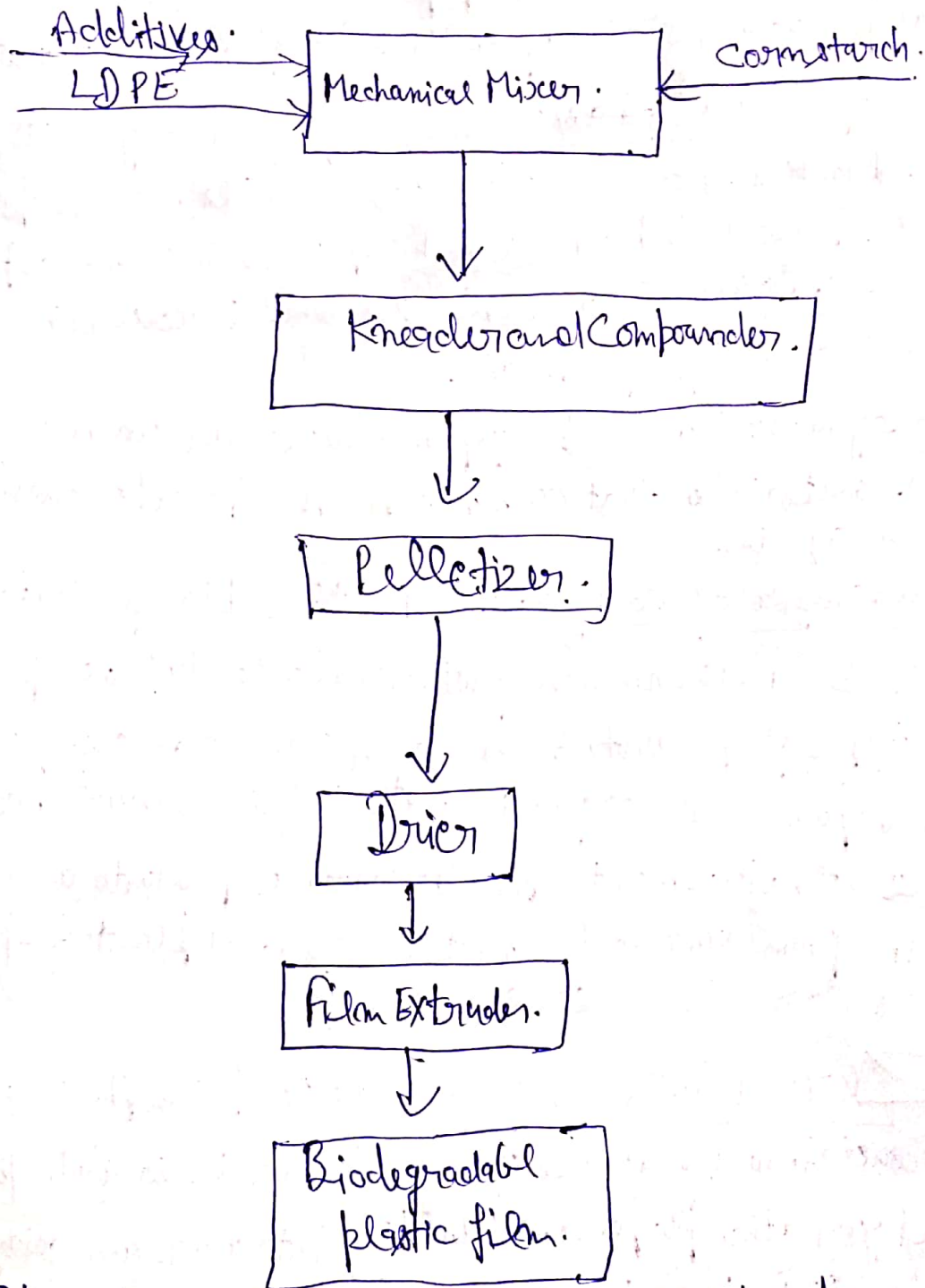
Nonbiodegradable may be defined as the name suggests another materials that cannot be decomposed or dissolved by natural agents..

Biodegradable products are made from sustainable materials and plant by-products, such as Corn starch or sugarcane.

The goal of zero waste is not to send products to recycling plants and compost heaps instead of landfills, but instead to use all of the product
